BOARD OF STUDIES

General

1. As an affiliated college, the syllabus of various courses, as laid down by Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University (AKTU), Lucknow is followed for all courses. However, at times, a closer look into the course coverage is necessitated to see if it is meeting the current needs of the industry. There is a need therefore to have a Board of Studies (BOS) in each department to examine syllabus related matters with a view to recommend either the augmentation of existing syllabus or to recommend some changes in the interest of students with Academic Council of the college for an in-depth examination and solution.

Composition

2. The composition of departmental BOSs is given below:

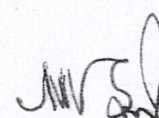
3. Each department will have a separate BOS, excepting following which are grouped as under:

- (a) EE and EN departments. HODs of two departments will assume charge of Convener, one by one, on yearly basis.
- (b) CS and IT departments. HODs of two departments will assume charge of Convener, one by one, on yearly basis.

Functions

4. The Board shall have following functions / powers:-

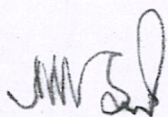
- (a) To make recommendations to the Academic Council in regard to the organization and co-ordination of instruction, teaching and training in the college.
- (b) To make recommendations to the Academic Council in regard to the number and qualifications of teachers, library facilities and/or laboratory equipment for each subject of instruction and training;
- (c) To report to the Academic Council on all matters referred to it by any department.



- (d) Generally, to advise on all academic matters falling within its purview.

Conclusion

5. A quorum of at least 4 members is essential for the meeting. Proper attendance record is required to be maintained.
6. All the departments must hold at least two BOS meetings every year, and the minutes be recorded for ratification / appraisal by Academic council.
