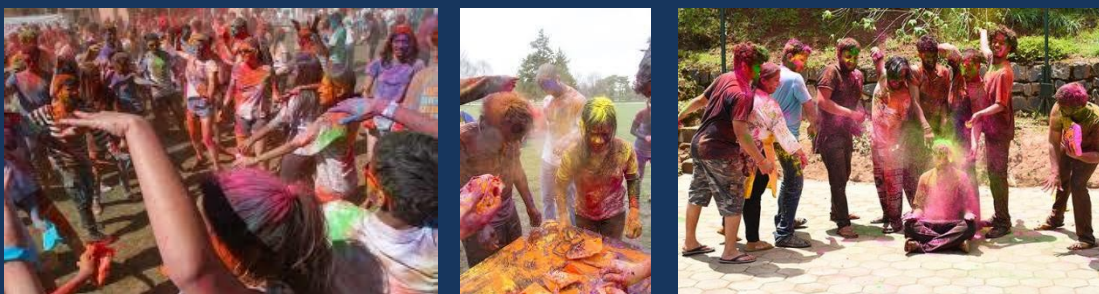
SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS

Lest you forget

- *All faculty members, staff members and students are required to follow proper dress code. I-card is mandatory.*
- *SRMGPC is a Ragging Free Campus and Trespassers will be prosecuted.*
- *No vehicles are permitted in the campus without a college sticker on it. Faculties/staff and students can purchase the stickers from admin dept by paying Rs.10.*
- *All students must abide by the general and special rules made by the college authorities from time to time with regard to their conduct and studies.*
- *Smoking, chewing tobacco, gutka, pan masala etc. is strictly*

- All the students who wish to occupy hostel in the next session are required to fill the hostel accommodation form available in the hostel office.
- Always carry Identity card. It should be tied with a string around the neck
- Do not roam around the campus during class hour.
- Be in proper college uniform.
- All rider and pillion are required to wear helmet.
- It is desirable to keep the campus clean- least we can do to contribute towards Swatch Bharat Abhiyaan.
- All students are required to maintain full attendance.
